Dr. Gray will be among the over 260 board-certified veterinary ophthalmologists across North America providing free sight-saving eye exams and preventive health reports for thousands of service dogs. These Service Dog groups include: guide dogs, handicapped assistance dogs, detection dogs, and search and rescue dogs. In order to qualify dogs must be active 'working dogs' that have been certified by a formal training program or organization or currently enrolled in a formal training program. All dogs must have certification and/or training paperwork to demonstrate their status as a working Service Dog in order to participate in this year's program. Owners/agents for the animal(s) must FIRST register the animal via an online registration format at: [www.ACVOeyeexam.org](http://www.ACVOeyeexam.org). Registration ends April 30<sup>th</sup> so act fast!

We look forward to participate in this important event and working with these incredible service dogs, in order to honour and repay these animals who are so dedicated to serving the community.
